ATHLETE PERFORMANCE AGREEMENT

The actions of a student-athlete are a reflection of themselves, their team, their school and their community. A student's involvement in school sports provides opportunities and experiences that are important to the development of a well-rounded student. However, student-athletes must remember that their participation in school sports is a privilege, not a right. In order to participate in athletics at Hope Secondary School, student-athletes shall:

1. Treat Everyone with Respect

- a) treat team-mates, coaches, opponents, event organizers and spectators with respect
- b) respect and accept with dignity the decisions of officials
- c) be generous in winning and graceful in losing

2. Exercise Self-Control at all times

- a) remember that there is no place in sport for drugs or alcohol
- b) refrain from the use of foul or profane language
- c) refrain from the use of physical force outside of the rules of the game

3. Play Fair

- a) play within the rules and the spirit of the rules of the game at all times

4. Conduct themselves within the school guidelines

- a) behaviour and conduct is within expectations outlined in school code of conduct and the student handbook
- b) Attendance is in accordance with the school attendance policy
- c) Student's participation levels on the team are within the coaches guidelines

If at any time a student is unable to meet the criteria listed above, he/she will be ineligible to participate in athletic events. A student that has been suspended from school will be ineligible to participate in sport for the duration of the suspension. Students are responsible for seeing teachers prior to missing classes and completing a Hope Secondary athlete homework form.

This agreement is drafted to provide our students with a structure to ensure they are able to present themselves in a positive manner in their school, community and in other communities.
