**STUDENTS ENTERING GRADE 10**

Students will automatically be registered for their core courses: *English First Peoples Literary Studies (2-credits), Math, Science, Socials & PE*

- Students will then choose one of the following to go with English First Peoples:
  - **Creative Writing 10 (2-credits)**
  - **Literary Studies / New Media 10 (2-credits)**

Students then have to choose **THREE elective classes**, which include:
